AT&T wireless workers have been fighting for months for a fair union contract that protects good, family-supporting jobs, but the company refuses to negotiate fairly. That's why workers may be forced to go on strike soon.

AT&T Mobility made \$13 billion in profits in 2016 and CEO Randall Stephenson took home nearly \$28.4 million in 2016. But when it comes to the workers who made that success possible, **the company continues to demand more work for less pay and outsource good jobs.**

AT&T Mobility has outsourced 60% of its retail stores to low-wage 3rd party dealers. Meanwhile, the company continues to close call centers and send jobs offshore to at least 8 countries and to lower wage areas of the US.

Support workers joining together to stand up to corporate power for good jobs.
