Participants will gather on campus at Kennelly Commons to call on the GRC Board of Trustees to **FIRE PRESIDENT EILEEN ELY** and begin to rebuild trust and confidence at the college. Over the last two years, college employees have repeatedly passed votes of **NO CONFIDENCE** in Ely for her actions, including:

- Prolonged contract negotiations
- Inadequate salary funding
- Negligent & oppressive policy decisions
- Harassment of employees
- Retaliation against union leaders
- Mismanagement of college resources

If anything, Ely's actions have gotten worse. She has unilaterally imposed an arbitrary numeric value to each college program as she plans further cuts. Those that inexplicably fall into the "5th Quintile" (the lowest 20%) in Ely's rubric are on the chopping block to be cut and their faculty fired. **ALL ARE URGED TO COME APRIL 22** and join Green River faculty and staff as they declare: "We Are All Q-5" and call for an end to Ely's tenure.
