According to Columbia Legal Services:

“Families who took part in a peaceful May Day demonstration calling on the Reynolds Work Release facility to respond to the COVID-19 outbreak have been punished for merely speaking out. Instead of heeding the call for safety, the Department of Corrections (DOC) aggressively retaliated. ... The men were thrown back in prison without due process and kept from communicating with their loved ones for weeks! ... They are locked up in unsafe conditions and facing additional time because the DOC claims they ‘went to the bathroom’ without permission, an excessive punishment that could be a death sentence.” (Full CLS statement: <https://columbialegal.org/press-conference-june-4-2020>.)

TO DEMAND THE HUMAN RIGHTS OF PRISONERS!

Universal Declaration of Human Rights (UDHR) Article 3: Everyone has the right to life, liberty and security of person.

Article 4: No one shall be held in slavery or servitude; slavery and the slave trade shall be prohibited in all their forms.

Article 5: No one shall be subjected to torture or to cruel, inhuman or degrading treatment or punishment.

Article 6: Everyone has the right to recognition everywhere as a person before the law.
