

NEED CHILD CARE?

YOU MAY BE ELIGIBLE FOR HELP WITH THE COST!

Working Connections Child Care (WCCC) is a Washington State program to help families pay for child care. High quality child care can help set your children up for success in kindergarten and beyond.

B C

Eligibility is based on your family's monthly income. If you qualify, the state will pay for the cost of your child's care at a licensed family home or center.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS:

- The child must be a U.S. citizen or legal resident.
- The family must live in Washington state.
- Parents will need to be working – if you are a full time student at a community, technical or tribal college, you may be exempt from this requirement.



HOW TO APPLY:

- Contact the Child Care Subsidy Contact Center at 1-844-626-8687 or apply online at www.washingtonconnection.org
- You will need to provide Department of Children, Youth, and Families (DCYF) with the following information:
 - Proof of your child's citizenship or legal residency (via passport, birth certificate, or Social Security Number)
 - Household members
 - Household income (via paystubs or other proof)
